33 DEFINITIONS
OF CHANGE

CHANGE: among other things a manual.

DEFINITION 1: TO GIVE AND TAKE RECIPROCALLY; TO EXCHANGE; FOLLOWED BY WITH; AS, TO CHANGE PLACE, OR HATS, OR MONEY, WITH ANOTHER..

DEFINITION 2: SPECIFICALLY: TO GIVE, OR RECEIVE, SMALLER DENOMINATIONS OF MONEY (TECHNICALLY CALLED CHANGE) FOR; AS, TO CHANGE A GOLD COIN OR A BANK BILL.

DEFINITION 3: TO BE ALTERED; TO UNDERGO VARIATION; AS, MEN SOMETIMES CHANGE FOR BETTER.

DEFINITION 4: TO PASS FROM ONE PHASE TO ANOTHER; AS, THE MOON CHANGES TO-MORROW NIGHT.

DEFINITION 5: ANY VARIATION OR ALTERATION; A PASSING FROM ONE STATE OR FORM TO ANOTHER; AS, A CHANGE OF COUNTENANCE; A CHANGE OF HABITS OR PRINCIPLES.

DEFINITION 6: A PASSING

FROM ONE PHASE TO ANOTHER; AS, A CHANGE OF THE MOON.

DEFINITION 7: ALTERATION IN THE ORDER OF A SERIES; PERMUTATION.

DEFINITION 8: A SUCCESSION OR SUBSTITUTION OF ONE THING IN THE PLACE OF ANOTHER; A DIFFERENCE; NOVELTY; VARIETY; AS, A CHANGE OF SEASONS.

DEFINITION 9: THAT WHICH MAKES A VARIETY, OR MAY BE SUBSTITUTED FOR ANOTHER.

DEFINITION 10: SMALL MONEY; THE MONEY BY MEANS OF WHICH THE LARGER COINS AND BANK BILLS ARE MADE AVAILABLE IN SMALL DEALINGS; HENCE, THE BALANCE RETURNED WHEN PAYMENT IS TENDERED BY A COIN OR NOTE EXCEEDING THE SUM DUE.

DEFINITION 11: A PLACE WHERE MERCHANTS AND

CHANGE: among other things a manual.

OTHERS MEET TO TRANSACT BUSINESS; A BUILDING APPROPRIATED FOR MERCANTILE TRANSACTIONS.

DEFINITION 12: A PUBLIC HOUSE; AN ALEHOUSE.

DEFINITION 13: : ANY ORDER IN WHICH A NUMBER OF BELLS ARE STRUCK, OTHER THAN THAT OF THE DIATONIC SCALE.

DEFINITION 14: THE ACTION OF CHANGING SOMETHING; "THE CHANGE OF GOVERNMENT HAD NO IMPACT ON THE ECONOMY"; "HIS CHANGE ON ABORTION COST HIM THE ELECTION"

DEFINITION 15: A DIFFERENT OR FRESH SET OF CLOTHES; "SHE BROUGHT A CHANGE IN HER OVERNIGHT BAG"

DEFINITION 16: A THING THAT IS DIFFERENT; "HE INSPECTED SEVERAL CHANGES BEFORE SELECTING ONE"

DEFINITION 17: A DIFFERENCE THAT IS USUALLY PLEASANT; "HE GOES TO FRANCE FOR VARIETY"; "IT IS A REFRESHING CHANGE TO MEET A WOMAN MECHANIC"

DEFINITION 18: AN EVENT THAT OCCURS WHEN SOMETHING PASSES FROM ONE STATE OR PHASE TO ANOTHER; "THE CHANGE WAS INTENDED TO INCREASE SALES"; "THIS STORM IS CERTAINLY A CHANGE FOR THE WORSE"; "THE NEIGHBORHOOD HAD UNDERGONE FEW MODIFICATIONS SINCE HIS LAST VISIT YEARS AGO"

DEFINITION 19: : THE RESULT OF ALTERATION OR MODIFICATION; "THERE WERE MARKED CHANGES IN THE LINING OF THE LUNGS"; "THERE HAD BEEN NO CHANGE IN THE MOUNTAINS"

DEFINITION 20: MONEY RECEIVED IN RETURN FOR ITS EQUIVALENT IN A LARGER DENOMINATION

CHANGE: among other things a manual.

OR A DIFFERENT CURRENCY;
"HE GOT CHANGE FOR A
TWENTY AND USED IT TO PAY
THE TAXI DRIVER"

DEFINITION 21: THE
BALANCE OF MONEY
RECEIVED WHEN THE
AMOUNT YOU TENDER IS
GREATER THAN THE AMOUNT
DUE; "I PAID WITH A TWENTY
AND POCKETED THE
CHANGE"

DEFINITION 22: COINS OF
SMALL DENOMINATION
REGARDED COLLECTIVELY;
"HE HAD A POCKETFUL OF
CHANGE"

DEFINITION 23: A RELA-
TIONAL DIFFERENCE
BETWEEN STATES;
ESPECIALLY BETWEEN
STATES BEFORE AND AFTER
SOME EVENT; "HE ATTRIB-
UTED THE CHANGE TO THEIR
MARRIAGE"

DEFINITION 24: UNDERGO A
CHANGE; BECOME DIFFER-
ENT IN ESSENCE; LOSING
ONE'S OR ITS ORIGINAL
NATURE; "SHE CHANGED
COMPLETELY AS SHE GREW

OLDER"; "THE WEATHER
CHANGED LAST NIGHT"

DEFINITION 25: MAKE OR
BECOME DIFFERENT IN
SOME PARTICULAR WAY,
WITHOUT PERMANENTLY
LOSING ONE'S OR ITS
FORMER CHARACTERIS-
TICS OR ESSENCE; "HER
MOOD CHANGES IN
ACCORDANCE WITH THE
WEATHER"; "THE
SUPERMARKET'S SELEC-
TION OF VEGETABLES
VARIES ACCORDING TO
THE SEASON"

DEFINITION 26: CAUSE TO
CHANGE; MAKE DIFFER-
ENT; CAUSE A TRANSFOR-
MATION; "THE ADVENT OF
THE AUTOMOBILE MAY
HAVE ALTERED THE
GROWTH PATTERN OF THE
CITY"; "THE DISCUSSION
HAS CHANGED MY
THINKING ABOUT THE
ISSUE"

DEFINITION 27:
EXCHANGE OR REPLACE
WITH ANOTHER, USUALLY
OF THE SAME KIND OR
CATEGORY; "COULD YOU

CHANGE: among other things a manual.

CONVERT MY DOLLARS INTO POUNDS?"; "HE CHANGED HIS NAME"; "CONVERT CENTIMETERS INTO INCHES"; "CONVERT HOLDINGS INTO SHARES"

DEFINITION 28: REMOVE OR REPLACE THE COVERINGS OF; "FATHER HAD TO LEARN HOW TO CHANGE THE BABY"; "AFTER EACH GUEST WE CHANGED THE BED LINENS"

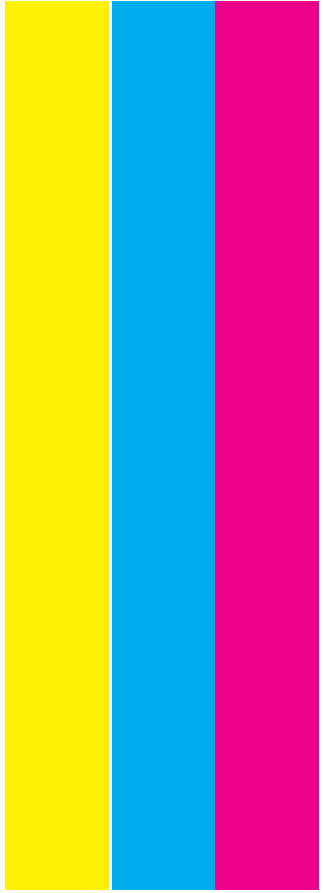
DEFINITION 29: CHANGE CLOTHES; PUT ON DIFFERENT CLOTHES; "CHANGE BEFORE YOU GO TO THE OPERA"

DEFINITION 30: : LAY ASIDE, ABANDON, OR LEAVE FOR ANOTHER; "SWITCH TO A DIFFERENT BRAND OF BEER"; "SHE SWITCHED PSYCHIATRISTS"; "THE CAR CHANGED LANES"

DEFINITION 31: BECOME DEEPER IN TONE; "HIS VOICE BEGAN TO CHANGE WHEN HE WAS 12 YEARS OLD"; "HER VOICE DEEPENED WHEN SHE WHISPERED THE PASSWORD"

DEFINITION 32: CHANGE FROM ONE VEHICLE OR TRANSPORTATION LINE TO ANOTHER; "SHE CHANGED IN CHICAGO ON HER WAY TO THE EAST COAST"

DEFINITION 33: : GIVE TO, AND RECEIVE FROM, ONE ANOTHER; "WOULD YOU CHANGE PLACES WITH ME?"; "WE HAVE BEEN EXCHANGING LETTERS FOR A YEAR"



WHAT WISE
MEN THINK?

CHANGE: among other things a manual.

IT MAY BE HARD FOR AN EGG TO TURN INTO A BIRD: IT WOULD BE A JOLLY SIGHT HARDER FOR IT TO LEARN TO FLY WHILE REMAINING AN EGG. WE ARE LIKE EGGS AT PRESENT. AND YOU CANNOT GO ON INDEFINITELY BEING JUST AN ORDINARY, DECENT EGG. WE MUST BE HATCHED OR GO BAD.



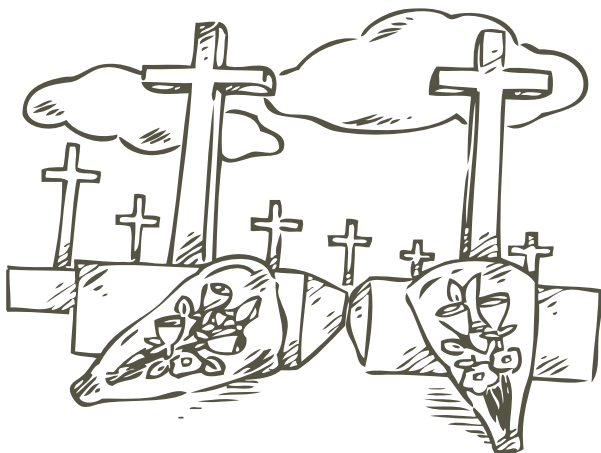
CHANGE: among other things a manual.

ETERY.



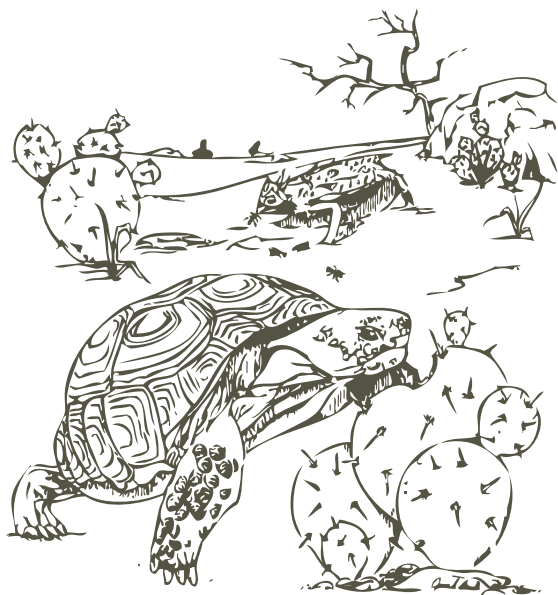
CHANGE: among other things a manual.

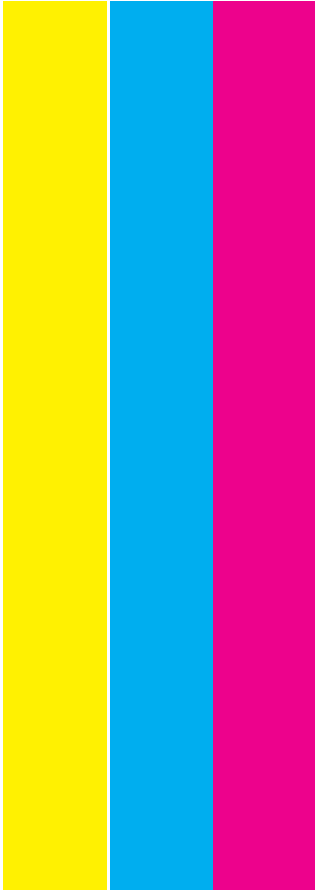

OVER.



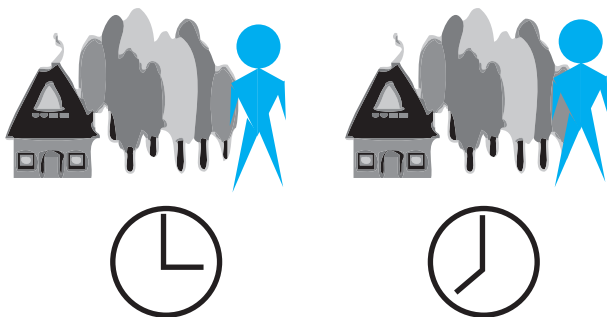

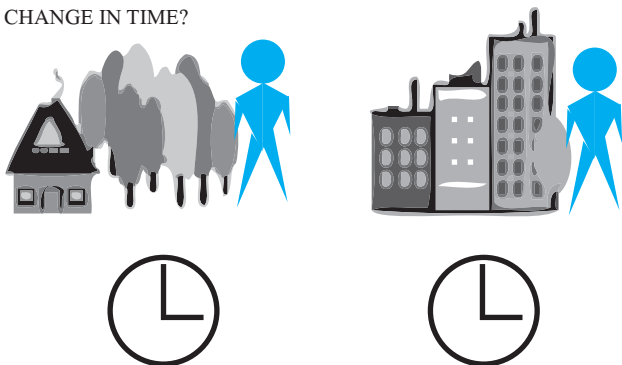
PARADOX

CHANGE: among other things a manual.

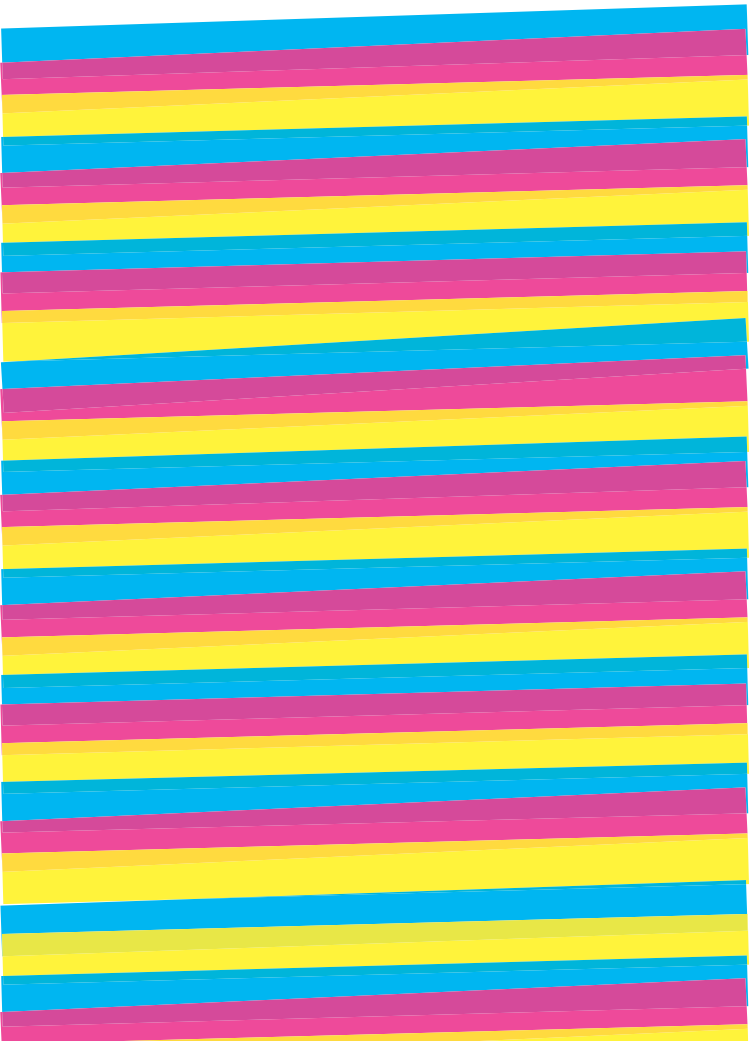
IS CHANGE IN TIME POSSIBLE WITH NO CHANGE IN SPACE?
